The other is a color coded list with all known transportation providers. This list is updated regularly and may include providers that have not been screened. Samantha updated the committee about the event Get on Board Day, sponsored by the Sierra Club on April 10, 2026. They may also be reaching out to Jennifer McIlhone to work out an event in Janesville. RSVP has been seeing more volunteers. They have been able to take up to 14 rides a day.

Rock County Transit has a new driver and dispatcher starting on Monday.

DOT Grants:

5310: Rock County Transit has used the grant to fund a new bus. They are still waiting for a bus that was ordered in November 2024. Currently, there are 2 new buses in the pipeline. RSVP uses the grant to fund their volunteer driver program.

85.21: This grant helps support the Rock County Transit general services and rides.
