



Minutes - May 16, 2022

Call to Order: Chair Beaver called the hybrid meeting of the Public Safety & Justice Committee to order at 5:00 P.M. on May 16, 2022.

Accepting High Intensity Drug Trafficking Areas (HIDTA) Grant and Amending the Sheriff's Office 2022 Budget: NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Rock County Board of Supervisors duly assembled this _____ day of _____, 2022 to approve and authorize the acceptance of \$65,000 of HIDTA grant funds and,

Supervisor Bomkamp moved approval of the above resolution, second by Supervisor Zoril.

Supervisor Zoril inquired why there is overtime built into this and if it could be used for non-overtime. Sheriff Knudson answered that when they apply for this grant, they ask how they will most likely be using the funds. DA O'Leary added that resources are limited, so to do this, employees must take on additional work which causes overtime.

Authorizing Acceptance of Monetary Donation from Milton VFW Post 9403: "NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Rock County Board of Supervisors assembled this _____ day of _____ 2022, that the Rock County Sheriff's Office is authorized to accept the monetary donation of \$15,000 from the Milton VFW Post 9403."

Supervisor Bomkamp moved approval of the above resolution, second by Supervisor Kudson.

Review, Discussion and Possible Action:

Authorization to Apply for Permit from the Department of Natural Resources to Place Slow-No-Wake Buoys in the Rock River: Supervisor Bomkamp moved to authorize the application for a permit from the Department of Natural Resources to Place Slow-No-Wake Buoys in the Rock River, second by Supervisor Knudson.

Richard Greenlee clarified that this is not the extension of the Slow-No-Wake zone. Rock County has a Slow-No-Wake Ordinance. The Rock Koshkonong Lake District has placed the buoys in this area. Fulton also had a Slow-No-Wake Ordinance. In the spring, the Town of Fulton rescinded their ordinance since Rock County already has an ordinance. Rich Greenlee recommended that the County apply for a permit for the buoys to be placed.
