Call to Order: Chair Richard called the meeting of the Public Works Committee to order at 8:01 a.m.

Approval of Agenda: Supervisor Mawhinney moved approval of the agenda as presented, seconded by Supervisor Rashkin. ADOPTED.

Approval of Minutes Dated February 14, 2023: Supervisor Woodman moved approval of the minutes from February 14, 2023, as presented, seconded by Supervisor Pennycook. ADOPTED.

Citizen Participation, Communications and Announcements: Mr. Jorgenson spoke about the possible implications if the deferred financing is not approved by the County Board for the CTH N and CTH X rehabilitation projects, including staffing concerns, alternative work options, contract impacts for materials that have been bid out and approved, and highway infrastructure conditions.

NOT OFFICIAL UNTIL APPROVED BY COMMITTEE

Supervisor Mawhinney thanked the highway workers for their excellent work getting the roads cleared quickly after the recent snow and ice events.

Parks Advisory Board Communications: Mr. Presny shared that the Friends of Rock County Parks (FORCP) held a meeting at Rock River Heritage Park on 2/28/2023 that was attended by almost 70 people! The purpose of the meeting was to start a Friends Group for Rock River Heritage Park. There is a FORCP meeting tonight (3/14/2023) at 6:30pm to continue moving forward.

REVIEW, DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION

Discussion and Possible Action – Purchase of Playground Equipment – Rock River Heritage Park: Mr. Traynor passed out and discussed two quotes that he received from Lee Recreation, LLC the previous day (see attachments) to install a playground at Rock River Heritage Park. Option A was quoted at \$91,213.35 and includes one large playground by Heritage Hall. This option may be too large for the area, as a certain amount of clear space is required around playground equipment for safety purposes.

Option B was quoted at \$94,868.35 and includes two playgrounds. A smaller playground would be installed by Heritage Hall, and another playground would be installed by the old archery range. This option would meet the clear space requirement and increase use of the park and playground equipment.

Supervisor Richard asked if a third option could be considered that focuses on the playground installation at Heritage Hall, delaying the second playground installation. Mr. Traynor answered questions from the committee and noted that both options are within the approved budget under Capital Improvement Projects. Mr. Traynor explained that the county will save \$10,000 in installation costs by using our staff to install the equipment. Mr. Traynor advised that he will have an Issue Paper for the Committee to consider in the future.

Discussion and Possible Action – Rental Fees – Rock River Heritage Park: Mr. Traynor discussed that when Rock River Heritage Park is fully open, the facility will be available for rental to the public. Mr. Traynor explained that Heritage Hall can accommodate approximately 300-350 people, and a rental would include the full day (5am-10pm), a clean structure, food preparation area, bathrooms, tables, chairs, and access to both levels of the hall. Mr. Traynor suggested possibly charging \$1,000/weekday or \$1,500/weekend day. Discussion was had about the idea of having a reduced rate for non-profit organizations and surveying other organizations to see what they charge for similar venues.

Supervisor Rashkin noted that the rental rates may need to increase or decrease based on demand and expenses incurred. Mr. Traynor noted that there are three other lodges at Rock River Heritage Park that could be rented out as well.

Parks Manager Report – See Attached: Mr. Traynor provided information on the items listed in his report and answered questions from the Committee.

Parks General

- Storm Damage Cleanup – Ice Storm- downed trees have been cleaned up, trails are accessible
- Picnic Table Rehabilitation- continuing to bring in 4-5 tables to work on
- Update to Spraying Equipment- Jim Hessenauer will be attending Pesticide Training through the Wisconsin County Highway Association to be certified to use a new growth inhibitor chemical to limit growth and clean out invasive plants
- Equipment Servicing- ongoing maintenance on mowers
- Wood-list Availability- wood is currently available at Carver-Roehl and Gibbs Lake, and will be available soon at Sportsman's Park to 2023 Wood Permit Holders
- Staffing Update – Seasonal, New Position- 3 of the 4 seasonal positions have been filled, there are at least 67 applications for the Parks Assistant Position, which will hopefully be starting around mid-April

Rock River Heritage Park

- Friends Group Update – Meeting Feb. 28th- went well, around 65 people showed up, 61 questionnaires were completed
- Kitchen Project- approximately 60 lots of kitchen and Hall items are currently up for auction at WI Surplus Auction
- Evansville School District – Day Class- have not chosen a date yet, will use outdoor shelter and fire pits

Beckman Mill

- Flooding Issue – Basement of Cooperage- no damage, was caused by someone leaving the water hydrant on, minor plumbing changes were made to the hydrant
- Boardwalk Rehabilitation – some boards need replacement
- Ad Hoc Committee – Contract Review- current contract for previous ten years expires May 2023, looking to extend for another ten years

Indianford Park

- MOU Update – RKLD- not finalized or signed but work has already begun
- Powerhouse Project Update- work has begun
- Parking Concerns- fisherman were upset with contractor taking all the parking, should be resolved

Carver Roehl Park

- Lighting Project Update- still waiting for ordered equipment to arrive
- Easter Egg Hunt – April 2nd at 1pm Sharp- don't be late!

Gibbs Lake Park

- Multi Use Trail Group – Grant Award – Signage- applied for and were awarded a grant to mark the trails and provide map signs at Gibbs Lake

- PAR 3 Meeting - April 13th – Rock County Host- meeting is at Rock River Heritage Park at 9:00am

Community Coordinator Report: Ms. Friend presented a PowerPoint presentation on items in her report. She shared pictures from Hearts in the Park (February 1-14, 2023, at Carver-Roehl Park) and the Friends of Rock County Parks (FORCP) Meeting on 2/28/2023. Ms. Friend noted that the FORCP has a meeting tonight (3/14/2023) at 6:30pm. Ms. Friend also thanked the Rock County Multi Use Trail Group for receiving a grant from the Wisconsin Horse Council to provide matching funds for a total of \$3,200 to purchase signs for Gibbs Lake Park.

Ms. Friend noted that the Leprechauns on the Loose is still going on until 3/17/2023, and leprechauns can be spotted at six different county parks (Beckman Mill, Carver-Roehl, Gibbs Lake, Magnolia Bluff, Rock River Heritage, and Magnolia Bluff Parks). Pictures/selfies can be submitted for the chance to win prizes for both people and dogs.

Ms. Friend shared that she passed the Certified Park and Recreational Professional (CPRP) Exam!

Finally, Ms. Friend shared reminders about the closures of the snowmobile trails, the restrooms at Sportman's Park, upper gate to Magnolia Bluff, and horse trails at Magnolia Bluff and Gibbs Lake. Boat Launch fees will be in effect from April 15 – October 31, 2023. Upcoming Events include I-Spy Egg Hunt and Eggs-ercise at Rock River Heritage Park, Friends of Carver-Roehl Egg Hunt (4/2), Friends of Beckman Mill Opening Day (5/6), and Friends of Rock County Parks Annual Bike Ride at Turtle Creek Parkway (5/20).

Next Meeting Date and Time: Tuesday, April 11, 2023, at 8:00 a.m. at the Department of Public Works.

Adjournment: Supervisor Mawhinney moved adjournment at 9:18 a.m., seconded by Supervisor Woodman. ADOPTED.

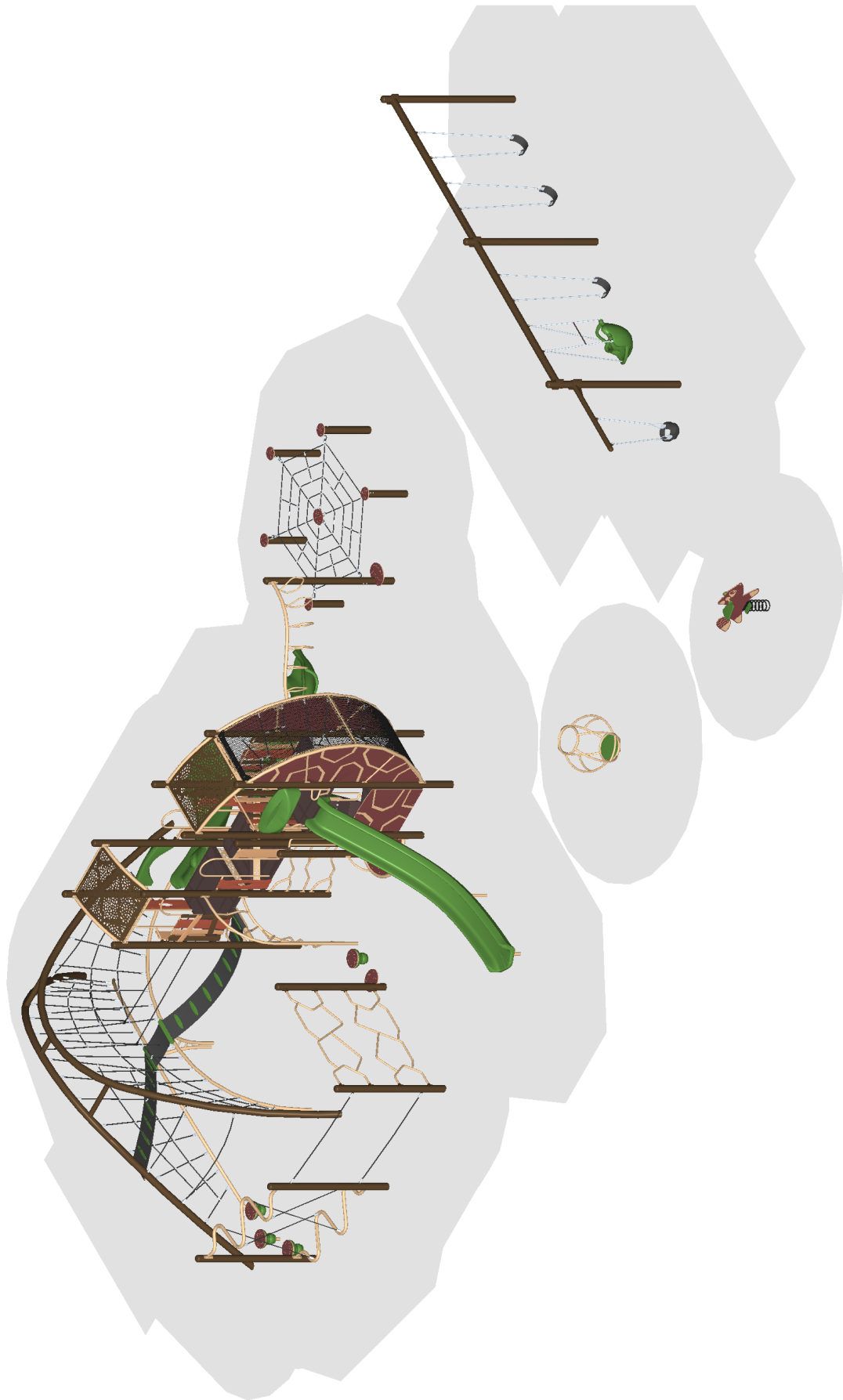

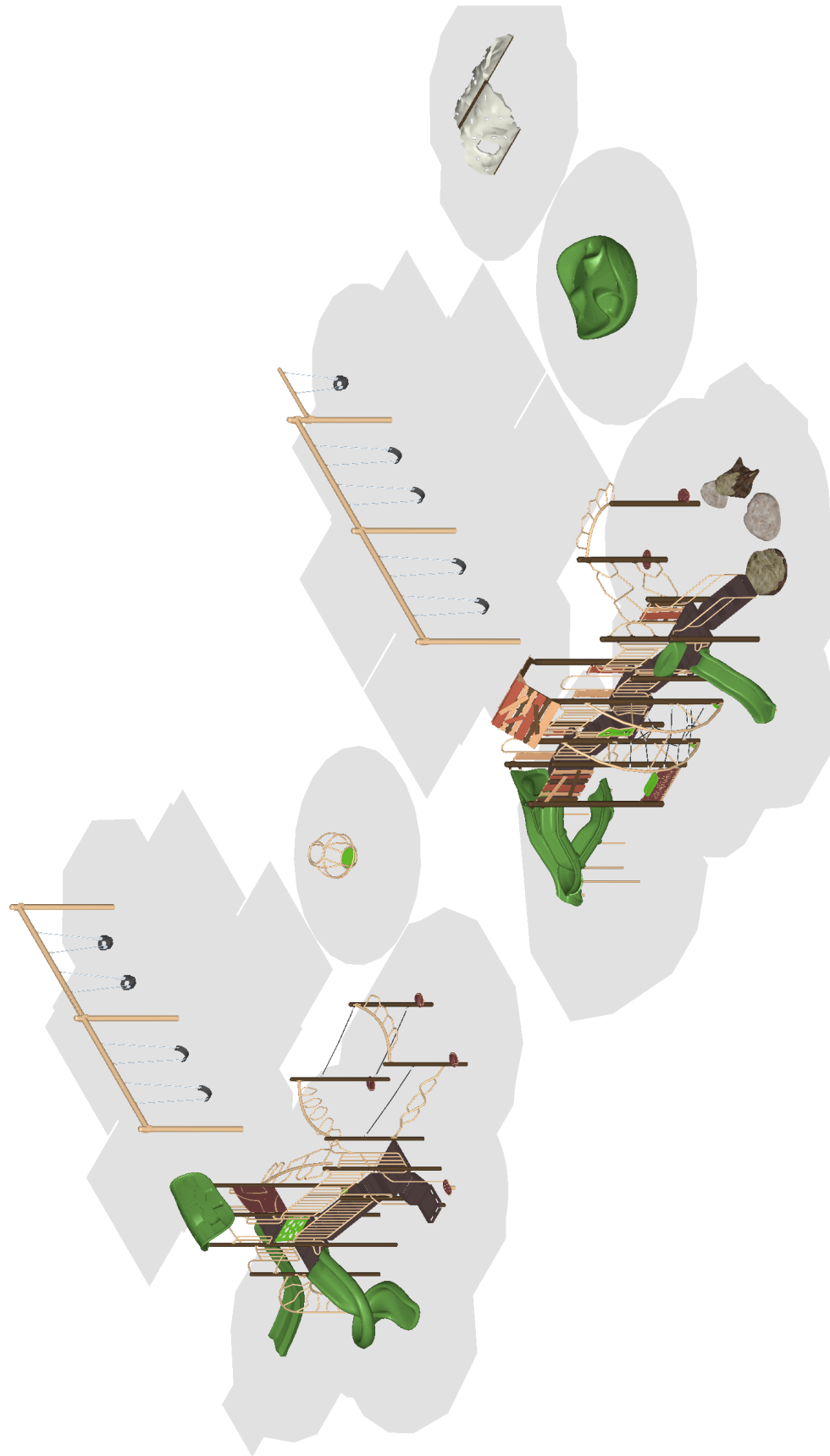
