Monday, February 21, 2022

Meeting of the Rock County Board of Canvassers opened at 9:00 a.m. on Monday, February 21, 2022. Members present: Larry Holterman (Republican Representative), Mark Fuller (Democratic Representative), and Lisa Tollefson (County Clerk). Others Present: Joelle Strand (County Clerk Specialist)

Agenda approved unanimously.

The Board of Canvassers reviewed Inspector's Statements and machine tapes for County Supervisor District 3. There were no registered write-ins or provisional ballots. The City of Edgerton was the only polling location with a county race.

Machine Audit – City of Edgerton – County Supervisor District 3

During the audit it was noticed that on one ballot a voter filled in an oval for Matt McIntyre and wrote in an un-registered candidate on the write-in line for County Board Supervisor District 3 without filing in the write-in oval.

In this case where a voter has filled in the oval next to a ballot candidate and has also written in a name but did not fill in the oval next to the write-in line, the equipment will “see” only the vote marked for the ballot candidate and record that vote. In this case, the inspectors must adjust the machine tape to subtract one vote from the ballot candidate’s total and then determine the eligibility of the vote for the write-in candidate.

The County Board of Canvassers agreed a vote would be subtracted from Matt McIntyre and a vote added to the write-ins. The new totals are below.
