Monday, April 8, 2024

Meeting of the Rock County Board of Canvassers opened at 9:00 a.m. on Monday, April 8, 2024. Members present: Larry Holterman (Republican Representative), Mark Fuller (Democratic Representative) and Lisa Tollefson (County Clerk). Others present: Jaymee Stephens and Karen Baierl (County Clerk's Office Staff).

Larry Holterman and Mark Fuller moved to approve the agenda. Agenda approved by acclamation.
