

**MINUTES OF THE BOARD OF CANVASSERS OF ROCK COUNTY**  
**RECOUNT of the Office of County Supervisor for District 11 and District 13**  
**in the April 2, 2024 Spring Election**  
**51 S. Main St., Courthouse Conference Center – 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor, Janesville, Wisconsin**

**Friday, April 12, 2024**

Meeting was called to order at 9:03 a.m.

Members of the Rock County Board of Canvassers were introduced: Larry Holterman – Republican Representative, Mark Fuller – Democratic Representative and County Clerk Lisa Tollefson.

Larry Holterman and Mark Fuller moved to approve the agenda. Agenda approved by voice vote.

Oath of Office was given to all tabulators: Dawn Miller, Leah Hurtley, Tiffany Chinn Barsness, Karen Baierl, Jaymee Stephens, Marcy Granger, Rebecca Wallendal and Cathy Blackburn.

Board of Canvassers agreed to hand count the ballots and follow the procedures set forth in the Wisconsin Election Commission's Recount Manual - *Election Recount Procedures – April 2024*. Polling locations would be reviewed first, then central count.

**County Supervisor District 11 – Recount**  
**City of Beloit Wards 7, 8, 9 and 11**

At the County Board of Canvassers meeting on April 8, 2024, the vote totals for each County Supervisor - District 11 candidate were determined to be 190 - 190. A tie between Lori Marshall and Brandon Buchanan. To determine the winner of the contest, a name was randomly drawn. Lori Marshall's name was drawn and determined the winner.

Brandon Buchanan filed his Recount Petition in the Rock County Clerk's office on April 10, 2024, and was notified of the location, date and time for the Recount at the time of filing. The Board of Canvassers were noticed with the Order of Recount on April 10, 2024. Lori Marshall accepted service on the Notice of Recount on April 10, 2024. The Board of Canvassers meeting was posted on April 11, 2024, more than 24 hours in advance of the meeting in compliance with the Open Meetings Law.

Erik Olsen (Candidate Primary for Lori Marshall) moved to strike the recount stating the petition does not meet statutory requirements and must include the following: (Summary)

1. Verified petitioner was a candidate for office. (Yes, complies.)
2. Petition states there were mistakes or errors. (Yes, complies.)
3. Candidate must state they are the aggrieved party. (Not stated on petition.)
4. Verify sworn statement. (Yes, verified that facts are true, but must state aggrieved party.)
5. Verified petition filed timely (Yes, filed timely.)

Therefore, the Buchanan petition for recount should be considered void and deficient for the election held on April 2, 2024.

Eduardo Castro (Candidate Primary for Brandon Buchanan) stated the following: (Summary)

1. Petition can be amended by the Board of Canvassers if they choose.
2. County Clerk accepted and thus is valid.

Board of Canvassers discussed and denied the objection to strike the recount. The petition from Brandon Buchanan matches the form EL-168 (Rev.3/2024) on the Wisconsin Elections Commission website and in the Wisconsin Elections Commission Election Recount Procedures Manual – April 2024.

Recount proceeded.

Pertinent voting information is as follows for each Reporting Unit in numerical order by Ward. All Election Day polling locations first, then followed by the absentee ballots processed at the Central Count location.

Eduardo Castro (Primary for Brandon Buchanan) objected to Election Day Registration at address 960 Hackett not being in District 11. Confirmed 960 Hackett is in County Supervisory District 12. Voter was not eligible to vote in Supervisory District 11. Board of Canvassers unanimously agreed to draw down one ballot. Ballot drawn down randomly was for Brandon Buchanan. One vote deducted from Brandon Buchanan's totals.

Confirmed the number of absentee voters – 30. Confirmed ballot bag seal matched on Inspectors' statement – 00184661. Ballot bag opened for recount of Ward 7. No remade ballots.

Number of absentee ballots – 30. Number of ballots hand-counted – 30.

Absentee ballot missing voter signature was found. The missing voter signature belonged to candidate petitioning for the recount – Brandon Buchanan. Neither Candidate Primaries objected to the ballot being counted. Much discussion on the subject.

Candidate Primary for Lori Marshall accused County Clerk of superfluously searching through the absentee envelopes to find a ballot to pull down to help his candidate's opponent.

Board of Canvasser members reminded those present that it is the job of the Board of Canvassers to determine that the election processes were followed properly on election day.

Board of Canvassers determined that the ballot should have been rejected at Central Count on election Day. One ballot should be drawn down.

Lunch break at 12:10 p.m.

Reconvened at 12:30 p.m.

Both Candidate Primaries came to an agreement that no ballot draw down should take place.

County Clerk Lisa Tollefson read from Chapter 9 of the Wisconsin State Statutes.

**9.01(1)(b)2.** The board of canvassers shall then examine the absentee ballot envelopes. Any defective absentee ballot envelopes shall be laid aside, properly marked and carefully preserved. The number of voters shall be reduced by the number of ballot envelopes set aside under this subdivision. An absentee ballot envelope is defective only if it is not witnessed or if it is not signed by the voter or if the certificate accompanying an absentee ballot that the voter received by facsimile transmission or electronic mail is missing.

**9.01(1)(b)4.b.** The board of canvassers shall then, for each opened absentee ballot envelope that was laid aside as defective under subd. 2., without inspection, randomly draw one absentee ballot from the

container or bag. In differentiating absentee ballots from other ballots, the board of canvassers shall presume that a ballot initialed only by the municipal clerk, the executive director of the board of election commissioners, or a deputy clerk or secretary is an absentee ballot. If there are more defective absentee ballot envelopes than there are probable absentee ballots, all of the probable absentee ballots shall be removed from the container or bag. Additional ballots shall be removed only if the number of remaining ballots still exceeds the number of voting electors recorded under subd. 1., reduced by the number of defective envelopes set aside under subd. 2. All ballots removed shall not be counted, but shall be marked as to the reason for their removal, set aside and carefully preserved.

Candidate Primary for Lori Marshall submitted copy of image from Brandon Buchanan's Facebook page.

Candidate Primary for Lori Marshall asked to have Brandon Buchanan swear an oath as to how he voted. Not allowed – a voter cannot be compelled to reveal how they voted their ballot.

Board of Canvassers followed state statutes and proceeded with the draw down of one ballot. Ballot drawn down was for Brandon Buchanan. One vote removed from Brandon Buchanan's totals.

The ballots for Ward 8 were sealed in ballot bag number 00186354. Drawn down ballot sealed in ballot bag number 00186367.

Primary for Tammy Green Gonfiantini objected to the following absentee envelopes:

- 1 - envelope was missing initials in the box for proof of identification.
  - Board of Canvassers denied objection. No ballots were drawn down. Statutes only requires initials for in-person absentee voting. In the re-design of the envelopes the clerks requested the second box to be added for consistency in processing. This was not an in-person ballot. This would also be considered a clerk error not a voter error. Also refer to 9.01(1)(b)2. for reasons as to why an absentee ballot is defective.
- 2 – envelopes found where the voter's witness signed the *Certification of Assistant*. Crossed out their signature in the *Certification of Assistant* location, initialed the cross out and signed in the correct location for the witness.
  - Board of Canvassers denied this objection. Witness signature is present.
- 3-envelopes found where the witness signed in the *Certification of Assistant* and the *Witness Signature* location.
  - Board of Canvassers denied this objection. The witness can also be the assistant. The witness signature is present.
- 1-envelope was witnessed by candidate – Genia Stevens.
  - 6.87(7) No individual who is a candidate at the election in which absentee ballots are cast may serve as a witness. Any candidate who serves as a witness shall be penalized by the discounting of a number of votes for his or her candidacy equal to the number of certificate envelopes bearing his or her signature.
  - Board of Canvassers agreed to remove one vote from Genia Stevens' total for Ward 2.

Primary for Tammy Green Gonfiantini objected to two absentee ballots without clerk's initials. Both ballots were for Genia Stevens.

- Clerk read from the Election Day Manual Page 98: "If the ballot does not contain the initials of the clerk or deputy clerk, do NOT reject the ballot solely for that reason."
- Board of Canvassers denied objection. Ballots are not drawn down due to a clerk error.

The two ballots objected to for Ward 2 were sealed in ballot bag number 00186359.

The remaining ballots for Ward 2 were sealed in ballot bag number 00186357.

Candidate Primary for Tammy Green Gonfiantini objected to the following absentee envelopes:

- 1 envelope - where the voter signed in the location for Assistant Signature instead of the location for the Voter Signature.
  - Board of Canvassers denied the objection. Statutes do not require the signature be in a specific spot on the envelope. The signature is easily read as the voter’s signature.
- 1 envelope - was objected to because the voter does not live at the residence listed on the envelope. Affidavit displayed, but not submitted to the Board of Canvassers as evidence. The candidate primary for Tammy Green Gonfiantini read a statement that the current resident stated the voter had not lived there the entire time he, the current resident, has lived at the residence. The absentee envelope was stamped “MAILED FROM A SECURE WISCONSIN INSTITUTION”.
  - Board of Canvassers denied the objection.
  - An elector may not use the address of a SECURE WISCONSIN INSTITUTION to register to vote. The elector registers to vote at the last location where they resided before they were arrested. 6.10 (7m)

(Please note: In anticipation of an objection to the elector’s right to vote, the County Clerk through her institution access confirmed the voter’s right to vote had been restored.)
