Update on Wisconsin Land Information Program

2022 Grant expires at the end of 2023. The planned projects came in under budget. Amend the plan to request an extension to allow the remaining funds to be applied to another project.

2023 Grant – Health Department's septic and permitting project. Currently reviewing data, import in October, review, go-live November 1. May include online interface for inspections, maps, converted data.

2024 Grant – Amount of grant reduced to \$10,000 which will be applied for when available. It will be requested for the 2024 Orthoimagery project.

Statewide Parcel Map Update

Data has been submitted, and reviewed. Next spring will be submitted with the Parcel Fabric, so should go even smoother.

Approval of Amended 2022-2024 Rock County Land Information Plan

Ms Borlik moved to put the 2022-2024 Rock County Land Information Plan on the floor. 2nd by Ms Dewitt. Would be advantageous to amend the plan and move up the next orthoimagery flight to from 2025 to 2024 due to smaller flight window, and more competition. Other municipalities are on board as well.

Update on Ongoing Land Records Projects

GIS Roadmap

Michelle, Todd, Randy and Jennifer have been working with vendor on a geospatial strategy to address use of GIS technology for other county departments. Created a GIS Roadmap to include Health Department-Public Health and Epidemiology, Administration, Emergency Management, Public Works – Highway and Parks, Human Services and County Clerk. Created a 3 year plan and shared with participating departments. Exploring logistics of implementation.

Parcel Fabric Implementation

Real Property has switched to totally maintaining the parcels in the parcel fabric. New GIS Specialist has experience with Arc GIS Pro. Working on the process to have the online maps update daily.

Historical Document Scanning Project – Planning

Coordinating with vendor to start scanning land division documents.

Septic Permit Project – health Department

2024 Imagery Acquisition

Orthoimagery is flown at either at 3 inch or 6 inch. City of Beloit and City of Janesville contribute to the project to have the more detailed 3 inch photography for their areas. City of Edgerton and City of Milton are also interested in 3 inch, but they have to be contiguous. Ms Borlick shared a preliminary map that would expand the 3 inch corridor to include dense areas of the towns and the additional cities. Preliminary numbers put the County portion of the project around 66,000. This would come from the LIP Grants and Retained Fees.

Open Data Hub / GIS Website Updates

Worked with vendor to explore an Open Data Hub that would allow users to access data on their own. Land Records Maps and Zoning maps apps will be updated.

Director/Staff Reports

Ms Disrud gave an update. WRDA is working on forms for shielding requests (Daniel's Law). Also Discriminatory Covenants bill is moving forward. This bill allows an owner who finds discriminatory restrictive covenants in their chain of title to record a disclaimer and discharge. Transfer fee bill is not moving forward.
