Meeting of the Rock County Board of Canvassers opened at 8:35 a.m. on Monday, April 7, 2025. Members present: Larry Holterman (Republican Representative), Mark Fuller (Democratic Representative) and Lisa Tollefson (County Clerk). Others present: Kris Kleisner (County Clerk Staff) and Sally Karlen.

Agenda was approved with random machine audit of Town of Plymouth – All Wards and Town of Lima – All Wards.
